# 1.Right to Education (RTE) Act – Central Government Fund Allocation for Tamil Nadu 2025 – ₹538.39 Crore:

• **Event:** Following the Supreme Court directive, the central government has released ₹538.39 crore under the **Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA)** for implementing the **Right to Education (RTE) Act** in Tamil Nadu.

### • Fund Details:

- 1. ₹362 crore Central government's share for the year 2024–25.
- 2. ₹175.59 crore First installment for the year 2025–26.
- 3. Remaining ₹175.59 crore for 2025–26 will be released later.

### • Exam-Relevant Points:

# 1. Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan – Integrated Scheme for School Education

- Launched by the Government of India in 2018–19.
- Objective: To ensure equitable quality education for all children from **primary to class 12**.
- Integration: Consolidates earlier schemes
  - SSA (Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan) Primary education
  - RMSA (Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan) –
    Secondary education
  - Teacher Education (TE) Teacher training and capacity building

### 2. Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009

- o Provides free and compulsory education for children.
- o Implemented from **April 1, 2010**.
- Objective: Ensures free and compulsory education for all children aged 6-14 years.
- Constitutional Status: Added as a Fundamental Right under Article 21-A of the Indian Constitution.
- o **25% Reservation:** Private schools must reserve 25% of seats for children from disadvantaged groups.
- Monitoring Bodies:
  - National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR)
  - State Commissions for Protection of Child Rights (SCPCRs)

# 2.Tamil Nadu Govt Allocates ₹1 Crore - Conservation of Endangered Species:

### **Department:**

Tamil Nadu Department of Environment, Forests and Climate Change

### Highlights:

- Tamil Nadu, home to the **Western and Eastern Ghats**, is recognized globally as a **Biodiversity Hotspot**.
- The government has allocated ₹1 crore for a new conservation project to protect species on the verge of extinction.

### Four Species to be Protected:

- 1. Lion-tailed Macaque
- 2. Chennai Hedgehog (native species)
- 3. Striped Hyena
- 4. Tor Mussullah (Mahseer Fish)

### **Ecological Importance of These Species:**

- Pollination
- Seed Dispersal
- Disease Control
- Hydrological Balance Restoration

### Objective:

To prevent extinction, preserve biodiversity, and maintain ecological balance in Tamil Nadu.



### Objective:

To generate electricity by pumping water between the Upper Bhavani and Avalanche reservoirs through underground tunnels.



#### Status:

- **2014:** A Government Order was issued to finalize **land acquisition** for the project.
- 2025 (April): The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) granted preliminary approval for the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) study. The Terms of Reference (ToR) for the EIA were also approved.
- **2030–2034:** The **construction phase** is expected to begin around **2030**.

### 4. Mysore Dasara Festival: State Festival of Karnataka

- Begins with **Navaratri** and concludes on **Vijayadashami** (10th day).
- Observed in the **Hindu month of Ashvina** (usually September–October).
- Mythological Significance:
  - Commemorates Chamundeshwari (Durga) defeating the demon
    Mahishasura (victory of good over evil).
- Mysore (formerly Mahishuru) is named after Mahishasura, the demon.


# **Science and Technology**

### 5.New Planet - SA 1107-7626:

- Swallows about **600 crore tonnes (6 billion tonnes)** of particles and gas **every second**, growing at an extremely fast rate.
- Discovered in 2008.
- Research conducted by: NASA space scientists.

### Features:

- Moves **independently in space** without orbiting any star.
- Has **intense gravitational pull**, drawing in dust, gas, and other particles.
- Its growth is **stimulated by magnetic fields**, similar to the process of **star formation**.
